

Entry Criteria

1. The prize draw (the "Prize Draw") is open to people over the age of 18 who reside in the UK and complete a valid nomination entry for the Girls Active Awards 2018. For rules regarding nominations please visit <http://girlsactive.youthsporttrust.org/categories-and-criteria/>
2. To enter the prize draw you must submit a Girls Active nomination form, either by post or online by the nominations closing date specified in point 5. Your valid entry to the prize draw is subject to providing your name and email address.
3. Only one nomination form or online entry per person. Entries on behalf of another person will not be accepted and joint submissions are not allowed.
4. Employees or agencies of Women in Sport and The Youth Sport Trust may not enter the prize draw.

The Prize Draw

5. The closing date for online entries is 11:45pm on Friday 20th July 2018. Postal entries need to be received by Monday 23rd July 2018. Entries received after this time will not be considered.
6. Women in Sport and The Youth Sport Trust accept no responsibility for entries that are lost, delayed, misdirected or incomplete or cannot be delivered or entered for any technical or other reason. Proof of delivery of the entry is not proof of receipt.
7. One winner will be chosen from a random draw of all valid entries received in accordance with these Terms and Conditions. The Prize Draw will take place on Monday 30th July 2018 and the winner's name and regional location will be made available on The Girls Active Award website.
8. The winner will receive a £150.00 voucher for sports equipment from [Youth Sport Direct](#). The winner will be notified by email on or before Friday 3rd August 2018 and they must provide a postal address to claim their prize. If a winner does not respond to Women in Sport within 28 days of being notified of their win, then the winner's prize will be forfeited and Women in Sport shall be entitled to select another winner in accordance with the process described above. This process will be repeated thereafter until a winner responds and confirms their acceptance of the prize.
9. Women in Sport and The Youth Sport Trust accepts no responsibility for any costs associated with the prize and not specifically included in the prize.
10. If a winner rejects their prize or their entry is invalid or in breach of these Terms and Conditions, the winner's prize will be forfeited and Women in Sport or The Youth Sport Trust reserve the right to select another winner at random.
11. The prize will be sent to the winner by Women in Sport by recorded post within 30 days of the winner's acceptance of the prize.
12. The prize is non-exchangeable, non-transferable, and is not redeemable for cash or other prizes.
13. Women in Sport retains the right to substitute the prize with another prize of similar value in the event the original prize offered is not available.
14. Women in Sport and The Youth Sport Trust accepts no responsibility for any damage, loss, liabilities, injury or disappointment incurred or suffered by you as a result of entering the Prize Draw or accepting the prize. Women in Sport and The Youth Sport Trust further disclaims liability for any injury or damage to your or any other person's computer relating to or resulting from participation in or downloading any materials in connection with the Prize Draw. Nothing in these Terms and Conditions shall exclude the liability of Women in Sport and The Youth Sport Trust for death, personal injury, fraud or fraudulent misrepresentation as a result of its negligence.

Women in Sport and The Youth Sport Trust reserves the right at any time and from time to time to modify or discontinue, temporarily or permanently, this Prize Draw with or without prior notice due to reasons outside its control (including, without limitation, in the case of anticipated, suspected or actual fraud). The decision of Women in Sport and The Youth Sport Trust in all matters under its control is final and binding and no correspondence will be entered into.
16. Women in Sport and The Youth Sport Trust shall not be liable for any failure to comply with its obligations where the failure is caused by something outside its reasonable control. Such circumstances shall include, but not be limited to, weather conditions, fire, flood, hurricane, strike, industrial dispute, war, hostilities, political unrest, riots, civil commotion, inevitable accidents, supervening legislation or any other circumstances amounting to force majeure.
17. The prize draw will be governed by English law and entrants to the prize draw submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the English courts.

Use of Personal Data

18. Women in Sport and the Youth Sport Trust shall use and take care of any personal information you supply to it as described in accordance with Data Protection legislation.
19. Women in Sport and the Youth Sport Trust will use your personal data to record and verify nominations for the Girls Active Awards.
20. By submitting a nomination, you agree to enter into the prize draw and to the collection, retention, usage and distribution of your personal information in order to process and contact you about your prize draw entry.
21. By submitting your personal information, you agree to receive a confirmation email and/or telephone call as necessary from Women in Sport confirming if you have won.
22. By submitting your personal information, you agree that if you are a winner your name and regional location will be made available on the Girls Active Awards website for transparency for all entrants.
23. Women in Sport and/or The Youth Sport Trust agrees to contact you if it wishes to use your information in any other way than agreed above (e.g. feedback, future publicity or advocacy opportunities).
24. Your personal data will be stored safely and securely and will be held for a period of no longer than 6 months from the postal prize draw closing date before being erased.
25. If you do not wish to be entered into the prize draw, please notify Women in Sport by email (see point 26) or post (see point 27) and your personal data shall be removed from the draw.
